Categories

Boys Lightweights:	Total Weight	105 kg	Individual minimum 25, maximum 40 kg.
Boys Heavyweights:	Total Weight	170 kg	Individual minimum 40 kg.
Girls Lightweights:	Total Weight	105 kg	Individual minimum 25, maximum 40 kg.
Girls Heavyweights:	Total Weight	170 kg	Individual minimum 40 kg.
Men Open Grades:	Total Weight	235 kg	Add 10 kg per veteran player aged 35-44 years. Add 20 kg per veteran player aged 45 years or above.
Women Open Grades:	Total Weight	190 kg	Add 10 kg per veteran player aged 30-39 years. Add 20 kg per veteran player aged 40 years or above.

Extra categories this year

Men Masters:	One player in each weight: U73, U90, +90
Women Masters:	One player U63 kg and two of any weight.
	All players in Masters Teams must be at least 35 years of age on the day.
	Players over 45 years may deduct 10 kg from their weight.
	Players over 55 years may deduct 15 kg from their weight.

Special trophies will be awarded this year for: Best Junior performance of the day and Best Senior Performance. In the event of a small number of Masters teams, there will also be an individual masters' open.

Notes

Each team should start with three players. If there are 2 players their combined weight must be no more than 75% of the total weight and the weight "missing" will decide which position in the team is vacant. Players below the minimum weight shall be deemed the minimum weight. Teams fight in weight order, lightest first. Players can fight in more than one category (e.g. Boys LW and Boys HW) if they meet the criteria but they may not fight in two teams in the same category. All players in boys and girls teams must be under 16 years of age (minimum age 8) on the day and seniors must be at least 14 years of age on the day. All players must possess a valid, in date BJA licence or equivalent and must wear white judogi. Method of competition will be pools, K.O. and repechage. BJA Level three point scoring event. There will be a "Swap Shop" board for any teams lacking a player or players looking to enter a team on the day. BJA Technical Restrictions will apply to all Junior Lightweight and low grade teams, irrespective of age or grade.
